The Family Justice Center (FJC) program provides free services to survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, and human trafficking. Our FJC is committed to fostering resilience for all survivors that walk through our doors and we do not do this work alone. We work collaboratively with our program partners and leaders like: Thurston County Prosecuting Attorney's Office, Thurston County Sheriff's Office, and Thurston County Clerk's Office.

ELIGIBILITY

- Survivor of intimate partner domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking.

The Family Justice Center is committed to serving survivors, wherever they are in their journey, by providing the tools necessary to empower themselves, reclaim their lives, and maintain their safety while doing so.

BILINGUAL SERVICES (English and Spanish)

- Confidential, direct services with an advocate that may include safety planning, crisis support, basic need items, assisting in legal support, and more.
- Connection to FJC partners and other community resources.
- Domestic violence peer support group.
