Our program is guided by the Strengthening Families Protective Factors Framework: Parental resilience, social connections, knowledge of parenting and child development, concrete support in times of need, and social and emotional competence of children.



SERVICES

The program offers a range of FREE workshops, groups, and services for parents in the South Sound region including:

- 1:1 parenting support tailored to the needs of each family. Whether it's CPS involvement, mental health, special needs, ages & stages development, or more, we're here to support you.
- Weekly Drop-In Breast/Chest Feeding Group- A casual, peer-to-peer group that is guided by our Parent Educator, where we talk about everything lactation.
- Monthly PowerParenting workshops- New topics every month, check out our website for more! Each class is adapted to the needs of the families attending the workshop.
- Connection to other community resources and services for parents and their children.
