ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Pear Blossom Place (PBP) is the region's largest 24/7 family shelter. In addition to 30 year-round shelter beds, there are seven permanent supportive apartments onsite. Each shelter room includes bunk beds, private bathrooms, and kitchenettes. There are also onsite children's play areas (indoor and outdoor), a community kitchen and living room, laundry facilities, and 24/hour onsite support from staff.

PBP utilizes a trauma-informed approach, recognizing the often difficult and sensitive circumstances that lead to homelessness. Our staff are trained to create a welcoming environment, fostering a sense of dignity and respect for all program participants.

ELIGIBILITY

- Have children under the age of 18 or prenatal.
- Must have completed Coordinated Entry (CE) intake.*
 - Families are placed from CE master list and shelter spaces may not be available immediately.
- * Not required prior to placement for cold weather shelter spots, open from November to April. Call 1-844-628-7343 for availability.
