## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

With the ultimate goal of empowering families, Pear Blossom Place serves as a stepping stone toward a brighter future, where families can rebuild their lives and thrive within the community.

Pear Blossom Place (PBP) is the region's largest 24/7 family shelter. In addition to 30 year-round shelter beds, there are seven permanent supportive apartments onsite. Each shelter room includes bunk beds, private bathrooms, and kitchenettes. There are also onsite children's play areas (indoor and outdoor), a community kitchen and living room, laundry facilities, and 24/hour onsite support from staff.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Have children under the age of 18 or prenatal.
- Must have completed Coordinated Entry (CE) intake.\*
  - Families are placed from CE master list and shelter spaces may not be available immediately.

\* Not required prior to placement for cold weather shelter spots, open from November to April. Call 1-844-628-7343 for availability.
